This Thanksgiving, our family traveled to Santa Fe, New Mexico, to spend the week with Jon's family.

We went to the historic plaza several times.

In the evening, as we stood there, we looked around at the surrounding buildings which had what looked like paper bags lining the edges.

As the sun went down, these bags became illuminated- a southwest decoration for the Christmas season.

Sunday, November 27, marked the beginning of Advent- our Christian season of preparation for Christ's coming into our world.

OUR PARTNER SCHOOLS: ROWLAND ELEMENTARY

Our Schools Ministry, benefitting Rowland Elementary School in South Euclid, is up and running once again. We are back inside the school! Yay God!

This summer and fall, with your incredible help, we ...

 ... raised \$1,000 for our free books program through our Holy Donut Day fund-raiser and raised \$1,800 for food incentives/assembly through our Book Giveaway fund-raiser, both in August.

 ... collected school supplies and gently used sweat pants and new underwear for students and delivered those to the school in August.

 ... assisted at the opening-of-school barbecue, providing popcorn, popping the popcorn and giving it out to students, families and staff.

 ... provided bottled water and snacks for the "Fathers Walk Their Children to School" event in September.

 ... returned to tutoring in the schools in October. We currently have three tutors – Ina Hardesty, Phyllis Wright and Pastor Jan – volunteering weekly or every other week.

 ... donated \$5,000 for a large-format printer to the school. This was a dream come true for the staff, which did not have a way to make posters or award certificates or anything very creative ... and now they do, thanks to Mayfield members Frank (pictured below) and Joy Clason! The Clasons were able to visit the school in November, see the printer in action and also get a tour of the STEM classroom. Frank said: "I'd happily spend a day there, playing with the neat gadgets!" Thanks to Joy and Frank, and their willingness to think "outside the box" and make this tremendous gift possible.





... In March, we plan to bring back the Spring Break Snack Bags for students at the school. The bags were discontinued in March 2020 when Covid closed the schools. Rowland's administrators tell us the bags are important as a good number of students receive breakfast and lunch at the school. When students are off school for nine days during spring break, some will receive only one meal a day. The snacks help our students so they have enough to eat. We expect – with the rise in food costs – that the snacks will cost \$6,000.  A POSTER MADE WITH THE NEW PRINTER!

Our study of the book “Hidden Christmas: The Surprising Truth Behind the Birth of Christ” began with our message on Nov. 27, the first Sunday of Advent.

Thanks go to “Faith and Food on Fincherie” LifeGroup member Gordon Gerber, who developed the questions in the study guide.

In the Nov. 27 message, I spoke about “Hidden Christmas” author Timothy Keller and his battle with pancreatic cancer, and I invited our congregation to pray for Keller and his family.

The day after, I received this email from his son, Michael, who, like his father, is a pastor:

My father is doing well, thank you. He went through about two years of chemo treatment. Once that stopped working and the cancer continued to grow, we have now switched to an immunotherapy treatment. So far it's working. Please continue to pray. We covet and deeply desire the prayers that have sustained our family and my father. We believe in the power of prayer, and God has been kind to us in so many ways through these past two years. Pray for stamina, for the continued regular scans, for healing, for peace in the midst of worry, for patience in all things. Thank you.


HOLIDAY BOUTIQUE

STEPHEN MINISTRY



HAPPY BIRTHDAY, STEPHEN MINISTRY!

Although Mayfield Church had a Stephen Ministry program many years ago, it had waned. A decade ago, recently trained Stephen Leaders Vic Matthews, Kathleen Vernon, and Mardi Atkins along with previously trained leaders Joyce Gordon and Bob Olbrysh, trained a new group of Stephen Ministers who were commissioned by Mayfield Church in 2012. This wonderful program has continued to this day and is ready to help people in our church as well as people in the community.

As we've learned through our recent study of Philippians, Paul found "Joy in Adversity" and Stephen Ministers seek to help our care receivers do the same. Whatever his circumstances, Paul learned to be content. Believers can have profound contentment, serenity, and peace no matter what happens. We can have joy even in times of hardship. Joy does not come from outward circumstances but from inward strength. Our Stephen Ministers consider themselves caregivers and honor God as the cure giver. Through our 1:1, confidential conversations with our care receivers, we look forward to continued opportunities to help them move through difficult times and find their joy in life.

FINANCE MINISTRY

If you are over 70.5 years of age and have an IRA, you can take distributions from your IRA, including your Required Minimum Distribution, and have the money sent directly from your IRA trustee to the church and you won't pay any tax on that distribution. On the other hand, if you can still itemize your deductions, you don't get a deduction for that contribution.

If you have a security (stock or mutual fund) that has appreciated in value and you are considering selling it, you can donate the security directly from your brokerage account to the church. You get a tax deduction for the full market value of the donation, the institution gets the full amount of the funds, and no one pays any income taxes on that donation. It is best to check with your financial advisor on their procedures. Please be warned that if you receive the check and then give the check to the church, you will still have to pay the Capital Gains tax.
